HEALTH ADVISORY | COVID-19 Vaccination Clinic Availability 11 January 2021

The *Health Alert Network* (HAN) is a communication system utilized by Jefferson County Public Health.

It provides timely distribution of critical and current health information.

Categories of Health Alert Network messages:

Health Alert Requires immediate action or attention; highest level of importance

Health Advisory May not require immediate action; provides important information for a specific incident or situation

Health Update Unlikely to require immediate action; provides updated information regarding an incident or situation

HAN Info Service Does not require immediate action; provides general public health information

KEY POINTS:

- It is VITAL that the links below are NOT SHARED beyond the intended recipient of this communication. There is limited vaccine available at this time in Jefferson County, and the vaccination providers across the county are working hard to address those in Phase 1A and Phase 1B "Above the Dotted Line". We have had two weeks where these links were shared, impacting the ability to get vaccine into the healthcare workers at the top of the phase list.
- Jefferson County Public Health, and all local health departments, have been asked by the CDPHE to focus our efforts on prioritizing vaccination for highest risk healthcare workers in phase 1A, as well as moderate risk healthcare workers, home health, hospice, dental and funeral services professionals, and first responders in the first half "Above the Dotted Line" of phase 1B.
- All other providers, such as hospitals, health systems, pharmacies, and safety net clinics, will be focusing on vaccinating persons 70 years of age and older.

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Important Information

At this time there is a limited amount of COVID vaccine available.

During this phased roll out we are <u>currently prioritizing health care workers and first responders only</u>. Due to limited quantities of vaccine, we are not yet moving further into Phase 1B, and are working closely with our pharmacy and healthcare providers to ensure that as more vaccines become available, we are able to get them to those who need them.

You will be asked to show proof of employment/occupation at your scheduled appointment.

Each eligible provider or health care worker will need to schedule an appointment to be vaccinated. **Appointments are first come first serve.** As additional vaccine is allocated to the county, additional appointments will be available and additional messaging sent out.

Anyone being vaccinated must:

- Be feeling well
- Not currently under quarantine for a COVID exposure within the last 14 days
- Have had no vaccines in the past 14 days

Safeway Scheduling Information

By using the scheduling links below, participants will be able to schedule an appointment for Dose 1. Please review the attached guide from our partners at Safeway that reviews the registration process, including how to schedule the Dose 2 appointment after getting the first dose. It is very important that participants schedule the Dose 2 appointment immediately after getting the first dose. Dose 2 appointments are restricted, so participants must follow the steps as outlined in the attached guide.

- Everyone will have a \$0 out-of-pocket cost for the vaccine. Please remember all participants who have health insurance to bring both their <u>medical and prescription</u> insurance cards with them to the appointment. Medicare recipients need to bring their new Medicare Part B card (red, white and blue). Government funds will be covering the of the vaccine for those that are uninsured.

JCPH Scheduling Information

Target population for Phase 1 COVID-19 Vaccination: Highest risk healthcare workers in phase 1A, as well as moderate risk healthcare workers, home health, hospice, dental and funeral services professionals, and first responders in phase 1B. *COVID-19 Vaccine will not be offered to people over aged 70 years who are not healthcare workers or first responders at this time.

1A: Highest-risk health care workers and individuals:

*People who have direct contact with COVID-19 patients for 15 minutes or more over a 24- hour period.

*Long-term care facility staff and residents.

1B: Moderate-risk health care workers and first responders:

*Health care workers with less direct contact with COVID-19 patients (e.g. home health, hospice, pharmacy, dental, etc).

*Dental Providers

*Funeral Service Professionals

*First Responders

Key Points:

- Following COVID-19 vaccination, a 15-30 minute observation period will take place. Wait time is dependent on each recipient's personal health risk factors. Please plan accordingly.
- The 2nd dose of vaccine **must** be the same brand (Moderna) as the 1st vaccine.
- At this time, it is strongly recommended that your 2nd dose is received at the same location in which the first was received to ensure accurate allocation of doses to each facility
- Signing up for a first dose at the North Arvada Drive-Thru POD will not automatically schedule a second dose.
